We Thomas Patten & wife Emma Patten have this day Benjamin
 & sold one half acre of land to Wm Ramsey B. F. Wilson & wife's meek
 joining the lot of land on which stands the church of Christ
 known as the Belham Congregation for the sum of Twenty
 Five Dollars Ramsey & Wilson paying ten dollars each
 Meek's paying five dollars the lot is bounded North by the
 South line on which the church stands East by the Road
 leading from Belham to Dechand South by the land of Thomas
 Patten & West by Patten the land is to be used for a cemetery and
 to be controlled by Ramsey Wilson & Meek's & their successors we
 have a good title to said land and have a lawful right to transfer
 & convey the same to the said party for the purposes herein
 expressed Given under hand and seal this November 20th 1895
