He married **Elizabeth Bohni**. She was born 29 Mar 1808 in Zunzgen, Baselland, Switzerland (Source: 1870 Jay Co., IN census.), and died Aft. 1870 in Grundy Co., TN (Source: Charles Scholer.).

Elizabeth, age 52, was living with her sons, Henry and John, in Madison, Jay County, Indiana during the 1860 census.

During the 1870 Jay County census, she, age 62, was living with John and his family in Madison.

After her son, John, moved to Gruetli with his family, Elizabeth came to visit them. It was here she died, and was buried in an unmarked grave on the farm.

4. Johann "John"² Scholer (Johannes "John"¹) was born 31 Jan 1832 in Zunzgen, Baselland, Switzerland (Source: Swiss Cemetery tombstone.), and died 11 Jul 1921 in Gruetli, Grundy Co. TN (Source: Swiss Cemetery tombstone.). He married **Margaretha Marianna "Mary Ann" Born** 08 Mar 1870 in Jay County, Indiana (Source: Indiana Marriage Record.), daughter of Unknown Bone and Anna Unknown. She was born 21 Sep 1846 in Ohio (Source: Swiss Cemetery tombstone.), and died 24 Sep 1913 in Gruetli, Grundy Co. TN (Source: Swiss Cemetery tombstone.).

Notes for Johann "John" Scholer:

John, age 28, was living with his brother Henry and his mother Elizabeth in Madison, Jay County, Indiana during the 1860 census.

John, age 38, and Mary A. age 23, were farming in Madison, Jay County, Indiana during the 1870 census. Elizabeth, age 62, was living with them.

John, age 48 and Mary, age 33, were living in Gruetli during the 1880 Grundy County census where they were farming. Their household consisted of Rosina age 7, Daniel age 5, Heinrich age 4 and Noah age 1.

John, age 68, and Marg, age 52, were farming in Gruetli during the 1900 census with 3 sons in their household, Henry age 22, Noah, age 20 and Jacob age 15. This census states they had been married 30 years and had 8 children with 6 living.

John, age 78, and Mary Ann, age 63, were farming in Gruetli during the 1910 census. Their sons, Noah, age 30, and Jacob, age 26, were living with them. This census states John and Mary Ann had been married 40 years and had 7 children with 5 living.

John's obit from the July 21, 1921 edition of the "Sequatchie Valley News" stated: "News has reached here of the death of John Scholer, of Gruetli, which occurred last Monday, the body being laid to rest in the Swiss Colony cemetery Tuesday afternoon. Mr. Scholer was 89 years, 5 months and 11 days old and had resided at the Colony for 51 years. He was born in Switzerland and came to this county when he was 23 years of age, first settling in Indiana. His wife died several years ago, and the following children survive him: Mrs. Rosina Nussbaum, Daniel, Henry, Noah and Jacob Scholer."

Notes for Margaretha Marianna "Mary Ann" Born:

Mary A. age 12, was living in Noble, Jay County, Indiana with her mother and brother in the Fred Judy household where her mother was working as housekeeper during the 1860 census. According to this census, she was born in Ohio. This census spells their name Berne.

Mary Ann's last name was spelled Berne on the marriage license in Jay County, Indiana.

The translated christening records for her children kept in the Swiss colony at Gruetli have her maiden name spelled Born.

Jacob, age 26, was living with his parents and older brother in Gruetli during the 1910 census.

Jacob's WWI Draft Registration Card states he was 34 years old, farming in Gruetli, his nearest relative was listed as John Scholer. He was of medium height and slender built with brown eyes and black hair.

At the time of the 1930 Grundy County census, Jacob, age 46, was living with his brother, Noah, in Gruetli.

5. Henry² Scholer (Johannes "John"¹) was born 30 Nov 1833 in Zunzgen, Baselland, Switzerland (Source: Charles Scholer.), and died 23 Mar 1902 in Jay County, Indiana (Source: Indiana Death Index.). He married

Anna Wuthrich 21 May 1867 in the Evangelical Reformed Church, Tenniken, Switzerland (Source: Charles Scholer.). She was born 08 Nov 1848 in Eggiwil, Bern, Switzerland (Source: Charles Scholer.), and died 27 Feb 1917 in Jay County, Indiana (Source: Charles Scholer.).

Notes for Henry Scholer:

Henry, age 26, was listed head of a household that consisted of John, age 28, and Elizabeth, age 52 during the 1860 Jay County, Indiana census. Henry and John were farming in the town of Madison.

Henry returned to Switzerland in the autumn of 1866, he and Anna married there and departed 4 days later to return to America.

Henry, age 36, and Ann, age 21, were farming in Madison, Jay County, Indiana during the 1870 census. They had 2 sons, Henry age 2 and Samuel, age 6 months. They were living next door to his brother, John.

During the 1880 census, Henry, age 46, and Ann, age 32, were farming in Madison with 7 children, Henry age 12, Samuel age 10, Elizabeth age 9, John age 7, Albert age 4, Charley age 2 and Edward age 7 months.

By the time of the 1900 census of Jay County, Henry age 66, and Ann age 51, were still farming in Madison. This census states they had been married 33 years and had 13 children with 13 living. The children 10 children listed in their household were Lizzie, age 28 and working as a milliner, John 27 and working on the farm, Albert age 24 and working on the farm, Charles age 22 and working as a furniture salesman, Edward age 20 and working on the farm, Frederick age 18 and working on the farm, Jacob age 16 and working on the farm, Noah, age 15 and working on the farm, Ida age 12, and Walter age 10.

She married **Francis Richard Nussbaum** 21 Jul 1895 in Grundy County, Tn. (Source: Grundy Co. marriage record.). He was born 22 May 1872 in Austria (Source: Swiss Cemetery tombstone.), and died 20 Aug 1913 (Source: Swiss Cemetery tombstone.).

Notes for Rosina Scholer:
Rosina was christened May 23, 1875 with sponsors being Samuel Jenni and Margaretha Maurer.

Rosina, age 7, was living with her parents and siblings in Gruetli, Grundy County, TN during the 1880 census.

Rosina and Richard were married by Chas. Nassbaum.

By the time of the 1900 census, Rosina, age 26, and F. R., age 28, were living in Gruetli with his father, Jacob.

This census states F.R. was adopted.

During the 1910 Grundy County census, she, age 36, and Richard, age 38, were farming in Gruetli. Their household consisted of 5 children, his mother and brother. This census states they had been married 14 years and had 5 children with 5 living. The children in the household were Harvy, age 9, John age 8, Hermedie age 4, Herbert age 3, and Eugene age 1.

By the time of the 1920 Grundy County census, Richard had died and Rosa, age 42 and widowed, was living in Gruetli with 5 children, Harvey age 19, Minnie age 13, Herbert age 12, Eugene age 10 and Edmond age 8.

The 1930 Grundy County census list Rosina, age 56 and widowed, living in Gruetli with 4 children, Herbert, age 23, Eugene age 21, Edmond age 19 and Hermine age 18.

Dan and Kate were married by J.L. White.

Dan, age 34, and Kate, age 30, were farming in Gruetli during the 1910 census. They were living between both sets of parents.

Dan's WWI Draft Registration Card states he was native born on Nov. 22, 1875, was a farmer, his wife was Kate Scholer, he was of medium height and built with blue eyes and black hair.

At the time of the 1920 Grundy County census, Dan, age 45, and Kate, age 40, were farming in Gruetli with 5 children, Fred, Ernest, Irene, Clyde and Katie Lucille. They were living next door to his father, John Scholer.

During the 1930 census of Gruetli, Dan, age 54, and Katie, age 50, were farming in Gruetli with 5 children, Fred age 19, Irene age 16, Clyde age 14, Katie age 11 and Earlene age 9.

Bud Hampton officiating. The deceased was born and reared in Gruetli, the daughter of the late Daniel Scholer and Mrs. Kate Pickett Scholer, who survives. The family had been living in Kentucky since 1945. Survivors beside her mother include a sister, Mrs Gabe Lietsinger, of Erlanger, Ky; three brothers, Fred Daniel Scholer, Cincinnati, Ohio; Jesse Clyde Scholer, Erlanger, Ky, and Ronald L. Scholer, Crescent Springs, Ky. Funeral services were conducted from the Allison and Rhodes Funeral Home in Covington, June 18th at 10:00 A.M. Foster & Son Funeral Home brought the body to Grundy County and were in charge of further arrangements."

Henry, age 32, and Caroline, called Carlana and 28 years old, were farming in Gruetli during the 1910 census. This census states they had been married 6 years and had 3 children with 3 living. They were Henry, age 5, Helena, age 4 and a baby daughter, age 2 months. They were living one house from her parents, John and Lissett Ruch.

When the 1920 census was taken, Henry age 41, and Caroline age 37 were farming in District 2 of Grundy County with 4 children, Carl age 15, Helen age 13, Louise age 9 and Hilda age 3.

During the 1930 Grundy County census, Henry and Caroline were living in Gruetli with 4 children, Louise, Elsie, Hilda and Johnnie E.
