1850 Franklin county Tennesse, William Erwin, 33 and Martha, 20 are found with no children. This may be our young couple as Franklin is adjacent to Grundy. He is a stone mason, born in Ireland. I believe his age is actually closer to 43. (page 83, RollM432)

1860 Grundy County, 6th District, Altamont PO. Wm Irving 53, and Jane 27 have 6 children, Frances (sp?) 10, James 8, William 6, Elen 5, Joseph 4, and Sarah 3. William's birthplace is given as Maine and he is a stonemason. A family of Paynes is next door, possibly Jane's relatives. A Meeks family is also nearby.

1870 Grundy County, Tennessee, Wm and Jane Irvin are living in the 7th Civil District with children Mary 18, Sarah 16, Kate 13, Kirby 10, Britton 3, and James 7 mos., PO is Tracy City. His age looks to be 53, which is not correct and hers is given as 48, also incorrect. Kirby's age is also incorrect. These discrepancies likely a result of second hand information or estimates by the census taker. He has real estate valued at 300 and personal prop. at 200. However, a Wm. Irvin, age 62, stonemason, does appear without a family on another page for the area. His real estate is valued at 500 and personal prop. at 150. William's birthplace is Ireland in both of these cases.

1880 Grundy County, Tennessee, W. C. 72 and Jane Irvin 48 are living in the 7th Civil District with children, Kerby, 15, Michael, 13, Clayburn, 10, and Robert, 8. W. C. is a stonecutter. His birthplace has been indexed as Maine, but. It looks like Ireland to me. Families named Meeks are living all around.

June 19, 1883, Land in Grundy County owned by William C. and Jane Irvin is sold to John Meeks.
