The grave in question is probably of Sterling Knight, and he was born 1836 and died in 1889. His family was some of the early settlers of the gulf, and his mother was Martha Savage, the gulf being named after that family. Both families were from Georgia.

There was another Sterling Knight, nephew of the previous Sterling Knight, so it could have been his grave with the stone in the gulf. Other family names from the gulf are Tate, Hobbs, Dugan and O'Rear, just to name a few.
