## **WILL OF BURWELL THOMPSON**

**In the name of God, Amen. I Burwell Thompson of sound mind and memory knowing that there is appointed time that all men has to die, I make this my last Will and Testament first I give my soul to God and my body to be decently buried by my executors then all my just debts to be paid out of my estate. Then I leave and bequeath to my beloved wife Margaret Thompson one negro man by the name of Jim[?] during her natural life and after her death the negro to be sold, and the money equally divided among my children, also my negro woman called Josy[?] to be my Lawful wife's during her natural life, and after her death the said negro woman to be sold and the money equally divided among my children and the third of all my property out of doors and in the house during her natural life and after her death the[?] am[?] those[?] to be equally divided between my son Samuel Thompson and my daughter Malinda Thompson. It is understood that heretofore I have given to my daughter Sarah McGowan one negro woman called Amy and all her increase, and [creased page] household furniture to be her part of all my estate. It is to be understood that heretofore I have given to my daughter Polly McGowan one negro boy named Ned and what household furniture to be her part of all my estate. It is understood that heretofore that I have given to my son George W. Thompson two negro men one called Dovy[?] and the other my the name of Harry[?] and all my other property out of doors and his part of the household to be his part of all my estate. I also leave and bequeath unto my son Samuel Thompson of my property that I now have in my possession at this time that he shall not be roughed[?] out of his part by the rest of my heirs that he shall have it[?] when he comes of age two negro men by the name of Lem[?] and Dave[?] and also one third of all my property out of doors, and one third of my household furniture all the forementioned property to remain with his mother, to be under her control to[?] my son Samuel Thompson comes of age, then the said property to be delivered to my son, Samuel Thompson. I also leave and**

**bequeath to my daughter Malinda Thompson of the property that is now in my possession two negroes one boy by the name of Jerry[?] and one girl by the name of Prish[?] and the one third of my out doors property and one third of my household furniture all the forementioned property to remain with her mother untill she marries or comes of age, then to be delivered to my daughter Malinda Thompson. It is my will that I leave my corn crop, that I have made this present year on both places to be given to my wife and my two children for to support them, and stock. It is my will that my son Samuel Thompson shall have my land, that I hold my son George W. Thompson's bond for title that when my son Samuel Thompson comes of age, that my son George W. Thompson shall make unto my son Samuel Thompson a warrantee title, and the said land is to be worked, and be the property of my wife, and my two children to make their support on the land – also my cotton crop that is now on the place to go to pay up the last payment, of any ownership[?] to be to the use of my wife and two children. I make this my last will and Testament and leave[?] David McGowan and Isaac Reed my executors revoking all former wills heretofore made by me – this will I acknowledge to be my last will and Testament Done and assigned by me this 18<sup>th</sup> day of October 1833**



My dear Senator:

In response to your letter of the fifth instant, I have the honor to advise you that from the papers in the Revolutionary War pension claim, S. 3801, it appears that BURWELL THOMPSON was born April 4, 1759, in Granville County, North Carolina.

While a resident of that county he enlisted in 1776 as a substitute for his brother, William, and served six months as private in Captain Parsons' Company, Colonel William Moore's North Carolina Regiment.

Having moved to Spartanburg County, South Carolina, in the winter of 1777 and 1778, he enlisted in the spring of 1778 and served nine months as a teamster.

Immediately after that service he enlisted and served four months as private in Captain William Nealle's Company, Colonel Williams' South Carolina Regiment, and was in a battle with the Indians on the Cherokee River.

He enlisted in 1780 and served about one year as private in Captain Roebuck's Company, Colonel Williams' South Carolina Regiment; he was in the battles of King's Mountain, Cowpens and Guilford.

He then enlisted and served about seven months as private in Captain White's South Carolina Company; he was in the battle of Eutaw Springs.

He also served under Colonel Wade Hampton.

He was allowed pension on his application executed November 27, 1832, at which time he was a resident of Franklin County, Tennessee.

There is no data on file relative to wife and children.
